1. Word classes (irregular morphology and syntax)
 - Verbs: irregular inflection; verb periphrases
 - Nouns: particular inflection cases
 - Adjectives: particular inflection cases
 - Pronouns: the inflection of case in the personal pronoun; the relative pronoun cujo
 - Determiners (consolidation)
 - Quantifiers (consolidation); partitive quantifiers
 - Prepositions and locutions (consolidation)
 - Coordination conjunctions and locutions
 - Subordination conjunctions and locutions
2. Syntax
 - Noun, adjective, adverb, verb, and preposition phrases
 - Clitics: enclitic, proclitic, mesoclitic
 - The structure of the complex sentence: coordination clauses; subordinate clauses
