Prerequisites

Before the course unit the learner is expected to be able to: Master the Spanish language at the A2 level, without this being an impediment to attend the course.

Course contents

Use the Spanish language with a communicative competence of level B1. 1 according to CEFR, without neglecting the 4 linguistic skills: listening, reading, speaking, and writing.

Course contents (extended version)

General revision of the previous level

- The house: description and location of objects, parts of the house, furniture and kitchen utensils
 The city: directions and location. Means of transport
 Verbal phrase "ir a" + infinitive
 Travel: descriptions of spaces and countries

 Comparative structures. Ask for hotel information and make reservations

- Present perfect and past perfect
- 7. Food: Spanish cuisine, going to a restaurant, giving and asking for food and menu information
 Affirmative imperative
- Syntax: direct and indirect object
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- 8. Syntax: direct and indirect object

Teaching and learning methods

 Final Written Exam 100% (The exam comprises the previously referred to 5 parts with different assessment percentages.)
