Course contents (extended version)

1. Language and communication
 - Communication process. Items of the communicative act, conditioning factors. Noise/redundancy
 - Semiotic material: verbal and non-verbal
 - Communication: interlocutory exchanges and one-way communication
 - Texts of the written type vs. Texts of the oral type
 - Verbal interaction. Conversation maxims and linguistic politeness
 - Language variation: diachronic, geographical, social, idiosyncratic variation. Standardization
2. Text / speech
 - The oral text
 - Prosodic phenomena
 - Oral communication techniques: from spontaneous to formal speech
 - Types of text in oral form: report, presentation/exhibition, comment, discussion
3. Expression and style in Portuguese language
 - The enunciation in the language - direct, deferred, reported
 - Discourse modality
 - Language registers
 - Stylistic processes: phonetic level, syntactic level and semantic level
