Learning outcomes and competences

At the end of the course unit the learner is expected to be able to:

1. use standard Chinese with communicative competences of level B1, according to the CEFR, including all 5 skills;
2. recognise and reproduce in their written (logograms) and oral (phonetics and tones, without resorting to "pinyin") forms all the logograms of this course, with respective etymology and categories;
3. understand and produce sentences, texts, expressions and dialogues of frequent use related to vocabulary and grammar previously acquired;
4. understand the use of directional verbs, predicative complements of simple and complex directions and specific sentences structures of ""(ba3) and ""(bei4);
5. demonstrate general knowledge of the contexts and contents of the 4 Great Classical Novels in Chinese literature;
6. work notions of translation from Chinese to Portuguese, based on the translation of short stories, traditional proverbs and Chinese poetry.

Prerequisites

Before the course unit the learner is expected to be able to: knowledge related to Chinese IV.

Course contents

Classical literature in the Republic of China. Introduction to the translation of traditional literature. Grammar and vocabulary items related to level B1.

Course contents (extended version)

1. Presentation of the 4 Great Classical Novels of Chinese literature.
2. Introduction to the translation of short stories, traditional proverbs and Chinese poetry.
3. Grammar contents 1:
 - use of ""(lai2) as predicative complement of simple and complex direction;
 - adverbial time adjunct with the phrase ""(de5shi2hou4);
 - modal particle ""(ba5) in declarative sentences;
 - predicative complements of result and degree;
 - aspectual particle ""(zhe5): continuous of duration of action; resulting of momentaneous action;
 - approximative numerals: ""(ji3) different adverb functions; ""(jiu4) modal adverb ""(cai2);
 - direction verbs; predicative complements of simple and complex direction;
 - emphatic forms: emphasis on the predicate; emphatic phrase ". / . ." (lian2, dou1/ye3);
 - predicative complement of possibility - structural particle for the predicative complement ""(de5);
 - use of the structural particle of the adverbial adjunct ""(de5).
4. Grammar contents 2:
 - meanings of the predicative complement of complex direction ""(qi3lai2);
 - specific sentence structure of optional or compulsory use of the preposition ""(ba3);
 - specific sentence structure with the use of the preposition in passive voice ""(bei4);
 - exclamative sentences.
5. Vocabulary:
 - organisation and hierarchy of a company: commerce, business, markets, travelling plans;
 - traffic, accidents, police;
 - housing systems: ads, renting contracts, houses, apartments, rooms, furniture;
 - electric appliances and their repairation;
 - opera, theatre, cinema, dance and other shows;
 - physical exercise and activities, fighting and martial arts;
 - tourism travelling, booking, taxi, hotelery;
 - thefts, lost and found, emergency numbers;
 - environment, ecology, the giant panda;
 - marriage in the Republic of China.
