Learning outcomes and competences

2. recognise and reproduce in their written (logograms) and oral (phonetics and tones, without resorting to "pinyin") forms all the logograms of this course, as well as their etymology and categories
3. understand and produce sentences, texts and dialogues of frequent use, with an emphasis on the particle ""(le5), interrogative pronouns, global interrogative sentences with ""(shi4bu5shi4)

Course contents

Grammar and vocabulary particularities matching the level of Chinese III.

Course contents (extended version)

1. Grammar
 - time nouns - formation of years, months, days of the week and dates
 - adverbial adjuncts
 - verbs of direction (simple and compound)
 - repetition (reduplication) of adjective morphemes
 - alternative conjunctions in declarative and interrogative sentences
 - adverbs of degree
 - demonstrative pronouns
 - simple and compound locative nouns
2. Grammar particularities 1:
 - sentences with the predicate 'have' ""(you3) - specific sentence structure
 - the place preposition ""(em)""(zai4)
 - adverbs of progressive aspect ""(zai4) and ""(zheng4zai4)
 - the use of the adverb of the future aspect ""(yao4) with the modal particle ""(le5)
 - interrogative pronouns ""(zen3me5) and ""(zen3me5yang4)
 - the use of the interrogative pronoun ""(zen3me5) followed by the final particle ""(la5)
 - rhetorical questions with the use of the interrogative pronoun ""(zen3me5)
 - the use of the aspect particle of experience ""(guo4)
 - the use of the modal particle ""(le5) to convey chance of situation
 - the use of the aspect particle for conclusion ""(le5) to convey an action already concluded
3. Grammar particularities 2:
 - specific use of the interrogative pronoun ""(ji3)
 - global interrogative sentence with the conjunction ""(shi4bu5shi4)
4. Vocabulary:
 - dates, hours, minutes, seconds, names for the different periods of the day and month
 - daily activities, leisure, sports and hobbies
 - forms of family and social greeting
 - lunar calendar, official holidays and traditional celebrations in the Popular Republic of China
 - holidays of Lusophone countries
 - public services and institutions
 - travelling and means of transport, locations and itineraries
 - cities and monuments in the Popular Republic of China
 - plants and pets
 - human body, health and disease, hospitals
