Teaching and learning methods

The curricular unit is organized into 4 modules that relate to each of the areas of expression developed throughout the semester, using 3 types of sessions: -Theoretical-practical (pedagogic content approach) - Laboratory practice (experience of contents of practical nature) - Tutorial guidance (monitoring, analysis and discussion of the theoretical and practical work developed and presented)

Assessment methods
