Teaching and learning methods

Theoretical and practical classes: theoretical expositions accompanied by reading and commenting on texts of literary theory. Reading and analysis of selected literary works: production of book reviews about those works (portfolio). Sessions of tutorials: clarification of doubts and individualized monitoring of the production of critical reviews in order to build a portfolio.

Assessment methods

1. Continuous evaluation - (Regular, Student Worker) (Final)
 - Intermediate Written Test - 50%
 - Portfolio - 50% (Individual portfolio with recensions made on the studied literary works.)
2. Exam - (Regular, Student Worker) (Supplementary, Special)
 - Final Written Exam - 100%
