### Course contents

Introduction to Commercial Law. Legal forms of the company. Commercial Companies. Cooperation between companies without creation of entity personified. Insolvency of companies: requirements, subjects and effects of the declaration of insolvency. The new institute of the special process of revitalization and recovery of the companies. Credit securities: concept; features; types: check, bill of exchange and promissory notes. The commercial hiring.

### Course contents (extended version)

1. Introduction to Commercial Law:
  - Trade in the economic sense and in the legal sense and the scope of Commercial Law;
  - Commercial Law as business law;
  - Acts of commerce: common regime of acts of commerce and commercial activities;
  - Subjects of Commercial Law: merchant and commercial entrepreneur; requirements; statute.
  - The commercial enterprise as central reality of Commercial Law: concept of company.
2. Legal forms of the company:
  - Singular company;
  - Collective company;
  - Public and public sector companies;
  - Group Company.
3. Business Partnerships:
  - Corporate elements; legal types of company; constitution: modalities;
  - Administration and supervision of companies; forms of financing;
  - Rights and duties of members; resolutions of the partners;
  - Transformation, spin-off, merger and dissolution of companies;
  - Groups of companies.
4. Cooperation between companies without creation of personified entity:
  - Consortium;
  - Association in participation.
5. Insolvency of companies: requirements, subjects and effects of the declaration of insolvency.
6. The new institute special process of revitalization and recovery of companies.
7. Credit securities: concept; features; types: check, bill of exchange and promissory notes.
8. Business contracts.
