Course contents

Help relationship; nursing process; identification of potential risk situations; safe therapeutic environment; quality of care; support to families; nursing records; professional secrecy; ethics in care delivery.

Course contents (extended version)

1. Establishes help relationship with the person in a situation of dependency and his/her family;
2. Applies nursing process to the person, aiming the improvement of well-being/ promotion of self-care;
 - Makes nursing diagnoses;
 - Plans interventions according to diagnoses;
 - Implements the planned interventions
 - Evaluates the results of implemented interventions
3. Identifies potential risk situations;
 - proposes and implements care aiming the prevention / solution of the encountered problems;
4. Promotes and maintains a safe and therapeutic environment;
5. Intervenes in order to create the conditions to maintain the person in his/her environment;
 - ensuring the provision of care with quality and safety;
6. Ensures support to enable families to integrate the patient's within them;
7. Contributes to the existence of information
 - nursing registries reflecting practices/health outcomes sensitive to those care
